WORK ELIGIBLE

Open to all Local Area Fine Artists over 21 years of age. Mediums considered include Acrylics, Oils, Watercolors, Gouache, Egg Tempera, Pastels, Textile/Fabric, Photography, Sculpture, Graphics (charcoal, etching, woodcuts, silk-screen, intaglio, original illustration in traditional mediums as ink and graphite, etc.) Work may be traditional or non-objective. Entries must be the artist's own work.

PROCEDURE FOR ENTRY

Each artist may submit up to 3 slides/lasers/pictures/photographs/digital images for jury. Please be sure that your submissions are representative of your work. Clearly write your name, address, phone #, and email address on all materials sent. Also, if you own a display setup that you would like to use in the show if you are accepted, include a photo/image of the setup as well.

Entries dated later than this will not be considered.

FEE STRUCTURE

The non-refundable entry fee is \$5.00 for Meriden Arts Council (MAC) members, and \$20.00 for non-members. Non-MAC members who submit an entry form and fee are automatically given membership in MAC for 1 year.

If you are submitting your entry form via email...

Upon receipt of your form you will be sent an electronic invoice for the entry fee. You will then have the option to pay by credit/debit card or via Paypal. Your payment must be received by September 8, 2010. If the entry fee is not received by this date, your entry form will be considered incomplete and your work will not be considered.

JURY OF SELECTION

The jury will consist of various members of the Meriden Arts Council (MAC). The decision of the jury is final.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE

Jury decisions are delivered via email and/or phone within 24 hours after decisions are rendered. Within one week of the closing of submissions, all accepted artists will receive a show information kit. This kit will include set-up and breakdown information as well as details about the accompanying wine tasting event.

WINE TASTING

The Fine Art Show is an outdoor exhibition within the perimeter of the Main and Vine Wine Tasting event. Therefore, all artists and anyone in a booth must be 21 and provide proper identification to enter the event.

Tickets to enter the wine tasting perimeter are \$15 in advance/ \$20 at the door. Each accepted artist is given **one** complimentary ticket which grants him/her entry into the perimeter. If the artist wishes to have additional people in his/her booth, each additional person will need to purchase their own ticket.

EXHIBITION RULES

If you are notified of acceptance, the following rules apply:

All work to be hung for display **MUST** be framed and ready for hanging.

All other work must be matted, preferably with glassine protectors.

Accepted artists must commit to keeping their displays up for the duration of the show (5pm-8pm). No Early Break-downs. No Exceptions.

You are responsible for the hanging/displaying of work in your booth. Please bring any installation equipment or supplies you may need. Extension cords, duct tape, hooks, hangers, table cloths, etc. **WILL NOT** be supplied.

You are welcome to bring your own tent/booth setup if you own one. However, the booth must pass the inspection of the jury. Please include a colored photo or digital image of your display with your entry form if you wish to use your own setup.

DISPLAY BACKDROPS AVAILABLE

For those artists who do not own a tent or display panels of their own, we have a limited supply of black 4'H x 8'W pegboard panels on which to display your work. Artists are responsible for bringing their own pegs and hooks for the pegboard.

SALES

There will be no commission taken from the artists who are juried into The Main ARtery Show. All proceeds will remain with the artists.

Artists will be responsible for sales tax collection and payment.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

The City of Meriden & The Meriden Arts Council, or anyone connected with this exhibition, cannot be held responsible for the loss or damage to any work of art submitted for exhibition consideration. All work submitted is subject to this condition which must be accepted by all participants. Signature on entry form constitutes agreement. We recommend artists carry their own insurance.
